

CH2M Beca Young Water Professional of the Year

Established in 2009, the *Young Water Professional of the Year* is aimed at acknowledging and rewarding one young water professional who has made a significant contribution to the water industry and the general community, and has demonstrated exceptional achievement in the early stages of his or her career.

This award recognises that the water industry encompasses a wide field of disciplines including, but not limited to, research, policy development, law, education, engineering, consulting, construction and community initiatives.

Judges and Judging Criteria

All entries will be assessed by a panel of three judges. The judging panel will comprise:

- one young water professional as nominated by the Chair of the Technical Committee;
- one Water New Zealand representative as nominated by the President; and
- one industry representative nominated by Water New Zealand's premier sponsors (from an organisation without a nominee for this award).

The judges reserve the right to not offer the award, or to offer an additional certificate of achievement, depending on the quality of entries. The judge's decision will be final. The successful candidate will be endorsed by the Technical Committee of Water New Zealand prior to announcement at the annual conference.

Prize

The total value of the package is currently \$2750.00. The Young Water Professional of the Year will receive a significant prize, including a suitable trophy, cash or in-kind goods or services, and a certificate of achievement.
