

Wairarapa Reorganisation Poll

PROGRESS RESULT

The progress result for the Wairarapa Reorganisation Poll held on Tuesday 12 December is as follows.

This result is based upon the counting of approximately 97% of the returned voting papers. The progress result does not include special votes and voting papers returned today that are still in transit to the processing centre. The outcome of this poll may change once all voting papers have been counted.
