#### **INDUSTRY PERSPECTIVE**

#### Contractor has sole design responsibility

- Promotes innovation, involvement and collaboration
- **¬** Changes in risk management
- **¬** Cost premium
- **¬** Changes in design input

## Principal's Requirements (PRs)


- Lack of quality of PRs
