











We work closely with Australian Standards, the ABCB, and various other organisations, including various Water Authorities. We also are a regular contributor to the Plumbing












In Australia not only do we have local Councils, but we also have Water Authorities and then we have our different States, and although we all work to the PCA and Australian Standards, rules and regulations do vary from State to State. Also, our licenses are issued by each State, so I can't work across Australia unless I get a license for each State and Territory.



In my home state of NSW, we have as the Authority <u>The Department of Fair Trading.</u> They have in turn passed over the governance of Backflow to Sydney Water, Hunter Water Corporation, Essential Water, (Broken Hill area) and then the various Councils in regional areas.






My working area includes Central Coast Council, Hunter Water Corporation and Sydney Water. I live roughly in the middle of Sydney and Newcastle. So when submitting paperwork I have three different organisations, that I must deal with, and they all have different internet platforms to accept the paperwork. In fact the C.C.C. has two different internet platforms for lodging paperwork depending where the job is

Most of these organisations are members of an association called WIOA. That stands for WATER INDUSTRY OPERATORS ASSOCIAITON. The BPAA is also a member of this organisation which allows us to interact with them with regards to Backflow





This enables us to be able to present at their Conferences presentations that explain exactly what Backflow is all about, and how it is their responsibility to have in place the proper procedures for recording the containment devices on a data base and as a minimum ensuring that they are tested and kept in good working order
